**1. Project Description:**

- Installation of approximately 3,024 LF of 16-inch DI CL250 water main
- Installation of approximately 1,353 LF of 12-inch DI CL350 water main
- Installation of approximately 263 LF of 8-inch DI CL250 water main
- Installation of water transmission main valves, valves boxes, blow-offs, and associated appurtenances
- Abandonment of approximately 3,480 LF of 16-inch water main
- Abandonment of approximately 400 LF of 6-inch water main
- Removal of PRV 12
- Cut and cap existing system at approximately 14 locations

**3. Pre-Bid Conference and Job Walk:**

Bidders are required to attend a **pre-bid conference at 10:00 A.M. local time on March 7, 2017** at the Morongo Band of Mission Indians Administration Building, 1st Floor Conference Room, 12700 Pumarra

Road, Banning, California. Representatives of Owner and Engineer will be present to discuss the Project in more detail. All contractors and associates will have to check in at the Guard Booth when entering the Reservation. Photo ID is required. Destination will be the Administration Building to meet with John Covington.

**4. Bid Security:**

The bid must be accompanied by a Bid Security made payable to Owner in an amount of 5% of Bidder's maximum Bid price in the form of a certified check or money order or a Bid bond as outlined in the General Conditions.

**5. Bid Opening Day:**

Bids will be opened on March 17, 2017 at 4:00 p.m., same time and date they are due.

**6. Payment Bond and Contract Bond:**

The successful bidder shall furnish to the Owner at the time of execution of the contract a Payment Bond approved by the Owner in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price. The successful bidder shall also furnish to the Owner at the time of execution of the contract a Performance Bond approved by the Owner in an amount equal to one hundred percent (100%) of the contract price.

The Owner reserves the right to reject any or all bids, to waive any irregularity, and to take all bids under advisement for a period of forty-five days.
