

## Household Hazardous Wastes Safety Tips

---

-  Use alternative “green” cleaning products.
-  Offer good, usable products to neighbors, friends and family.
-  Keep chemicals in their original, labeled container, if possible.
-  Label any unmarked containers with the contents.
-  If a container is leaking, place it inside of another container (such as a plastic bag or bucket) to prevent the leak from spreading.
-  Do not mix chemicals, even when transporting them to a collection facility.
-  If you use harmful cleaners, use the product to the most extent before disposing of the container.
